BMAT – BioMedical Admissions Test	http://www.admissionstests.cambridgeassessment.org.uk/adt/	This is a subject-specific admissions test you must take if you apply for certain medicine, veterinary medicine and related courses at: University of Cambridge, Imperial College London, University of Oxford, Royal Veterinary College, UCL
ELAT – English Literature Admissions Test	http://www.admissionstests.cambridgeassessment.org.uk/adt/	You must take this test if you apply for some courses in English at Oxford University
TSA – Thinking Skills Assessment Test (Oxford)	http://www.admissionstests.cambridgeassessment.org.uk/adt/	Students applying to the University of Oxford to study Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) and Economics and Management (E&M) will be required to take a pre-interview admissions test.
TSA – Thinking Skills Assessment Test (Cambridge)	http://www.admissionstests.cambridgeassessment.org.uk/adt/	Students applying to the University of Cambridge to study: Computer Science, Economics, Engineering, Land Economy, Natural Sciences (Physical & Biological), Social & Political Sciences (SPS) will be required to take a pre-interview admissions test. NB: Colleges have their own policies on which courses require the TSA. Please refer to the University of Cambridge's website for each college's requirements
