Please note:

- 1 Each subject will provide pupils with detailed information about what is required in their subject.
- 2 Control level refers to the amount of assistance staff can provide and the amount of work that can be completed outside the classroom. Thus, a High control level means that the work is to be completed in class under examination conditions.
- 3 While Science subjects do not have Controlled Assessment, they do have a PSA (Practical Skills Assessment) which is worth 7.5%. Pupils complete two practical assessments within one continuous two-hour session and record their results in a booklet which is marked externally by CCEA. The PSA must take place between 1st January and 1st May in Year 12. Unit 3 which includes the PSA is optional for the academic year 2021-22 in all 3 sciences and may be omitted.
- 4 While there are no Controlled Assessments in Modern Languages, part of the Speaking test is prepared in Controlled Assessment conditions but the full test is taken as a formal assessment.
