YOUR CHILD TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

WHEN CAN MY CHILD RETURN?
Your child can return to school after 10 days even if they still have a cough / loss of smell or taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks.

SOMEBODY IN MY HOUSEHOLD HAS COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

WHAT TO DO?

- DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL.

- The household enember should book a COVID-19 test
- Household self-isolates
- Inform school immediately about test result

SOMEBODY IN MY HOUSEHOLD TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

WHEN CAN MY CHILD RETURN?
Your child can return to school when they have completed
14 days of self-isolation without any symptoms, regardless
of your child having a negative COVID-19 test result.

CONTACT TRACING HAS IDENTIFIED MY CHILD AS A CLOSE CONTACT

YOUR CHILD HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT

WHAT TO DO?

- Attend school as normal

- If your child does not have any COVID-19 symptoms they should carry on with normal activities

YOUR CHILD HAS TRAVELLED ABROAD AND HAS TO SELF-ISOLATE WHAT TO DO? - Self-isolate for 14 days in line with quarantine advice
