Accelerated Reader Update



Accelerated Reader is now in operation for the 3rd year and has been rolled out to all Years 8, 9 and 10 library classes.

Competition to be AR stars gathered even more momentum, with our charts in the library showing both weekly progress between the classes and numbers of Word Millionaires (of which there were many!)

In June 2014 two lucky classes won the coveted prize of a day trip to the North Coast (featuring a visit to Barry's) They did this by reading the most books and accurately passing the most AR quizzes by achieving 85% or higher. The victorious classes were 8K and 9S

We also held 2 special achievement

assemblies to celebrate our reading success, where word millionaires were awarded certificates and prizes by Mr Peel.

In Year 8, 26 students were word millionaires or multi millionaires and Ollie Butt broke all records with an incredible 6 million words read tally!!!

In Year 9, 26 students also gained millionaire and multi millionaire status, with 5 students reading more than 2 million words.

As this is the first year that we have had all 3 junior school year groups participating, it has been a challenge to ensure we have a plentiful supply of reading materials in the library. More books at the higher AR levels have been purchased and a new library feature 'Reach For The Stars' lists our more challenging reads.

The popular author Dan Freedman was the special guest at the Finale and he gave an interesting talk about his writing and the world of sports journalism.


